CORPORATE BOARD OF DIRECTORS COMMITMENT REQUIREMENTS

Each Corporate Board Member shall be responsible for:

- A. Giving guidance and direction to the Club.
- B. Be an active fundraiser.
- C. Being advocates for the Club in the community.

Corporate Board Members are expected to:

- ❖ Giving guidance and direction to the Club.
 - Attendance of at least eight (out of 11) board meetings per year.
 - Participation on a minimum of one committee and one sub-committee each year of your term. Board members shall attend at least 70% of the committee meetings held each year. If this is not possible, the committee chair and board member can negotiate the committee participation.
 - Each board member is required to visit one Boys & Girls Club program/activity each year and provide verbal comments regarding the visit to the Executive Director. Examples; After-School Program, Middle school Dance, Athletic events or special event.
 - Each Board Member is encouraged to participate in Board Leadership trainings at least once in their three year term. Trainings available include the annual Boys & Girls Club of America Leadership conference held each winter, board trainings provided by your Club.
- ❖ Be an Active Fundraiser
 - All board members shall pay annual board dues of \$XX prior to each fiscal year. This money covers your annual board dues and your meal at the annual dinner.
 - All board members shall personally contribute at least \$XXX per year of which \$XXX will go towards a Campaign fund raising effort or some other fund.

- All board members shall actively participate in the Clubs core fund raising activities each year (Auction, Golf, Youth Partnership or other events). The participation shall involve soliciting cash and/or in-kind donations. Board members are expected to raise a minimum of \$XXXX each.

Possible ways to raise \$X,XXX or more a year:

The following are suggested ways to raise money fro the Club. These funds will be raised by utilizing you sphere of influence and leads from the Club.

Auction

- ◆ **Tickets \$100 per couple or \$400 a table**
- ◆ **Sponsorship; silent \$2,500, sponsor a kid \$5,000 and title \$15,000**
- ◆ **Auction items; friends & family and local businesses**

Golf

- ◆ **One player \$100 or a foursome \$400**
- ◆ **Tee or Green Sign \$250, Executive sponsor \$500, Senior Exec sponsor \$750 and Corporate \$1,500**

Youth Partnership

- ◆ **Encourage others to sponsor youth, through Club provided lists and your own network**

Team & Program Sponsorship

- ◆ **Sports team sponsorship \$175 - \$300 a season**
- ◆ **Program sponsorship varies for each activity and season**

- All board members are encouraged to participate in special event fund raising projects determined by the Resource Development Committee.
- All board members will annually invite at least two individuals to tour a Boys & Girls Club program. Examples; After-School Program, Middle school Dance, Athletic events or special event.
- All board members will advocate for the Boys & Girls Club within the community so that the youth may be better served. An example is to support the club through local service clubs.
