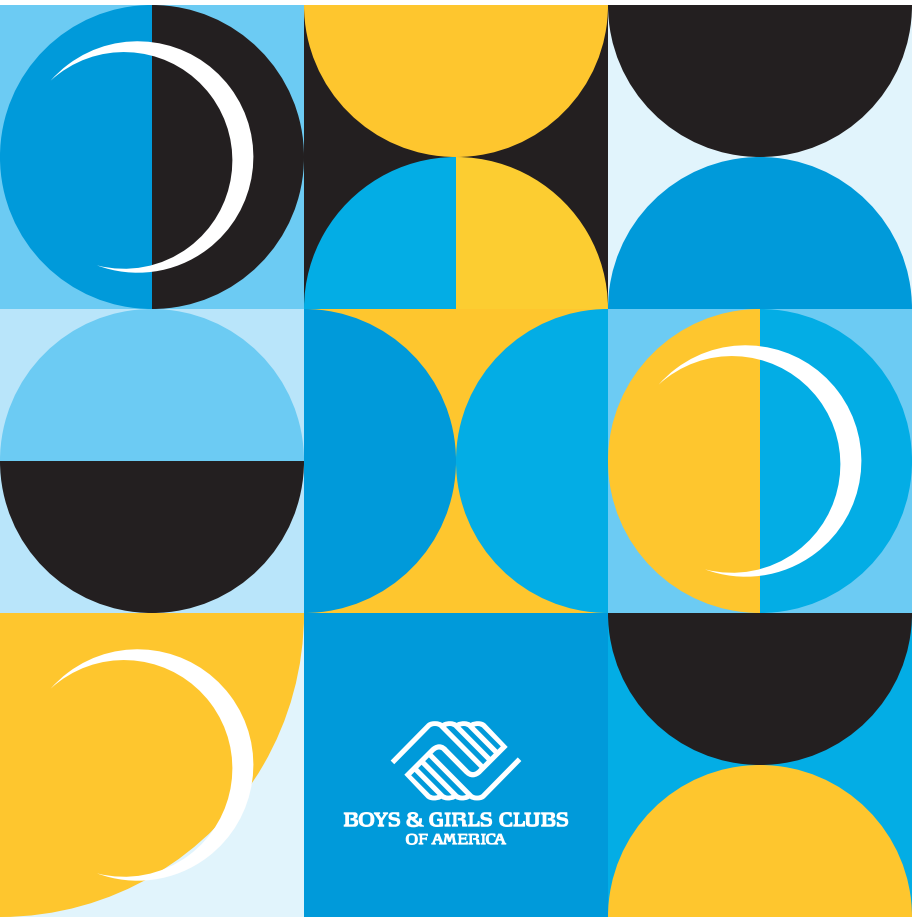

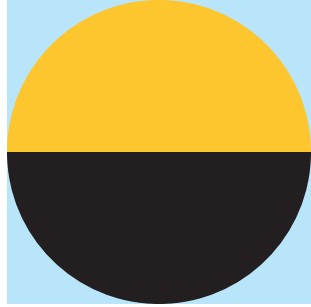

## **LEAD**

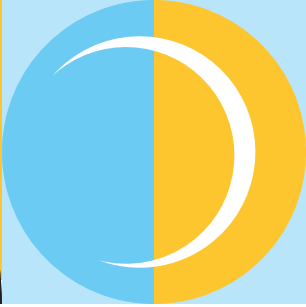
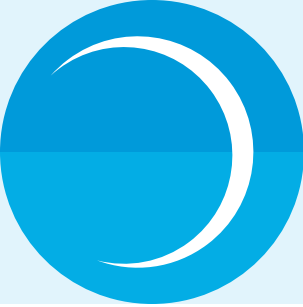
Ensure an up-to-date and board-approved strategic plan is in place to drive strategic initiatives.

(85% to 89%)

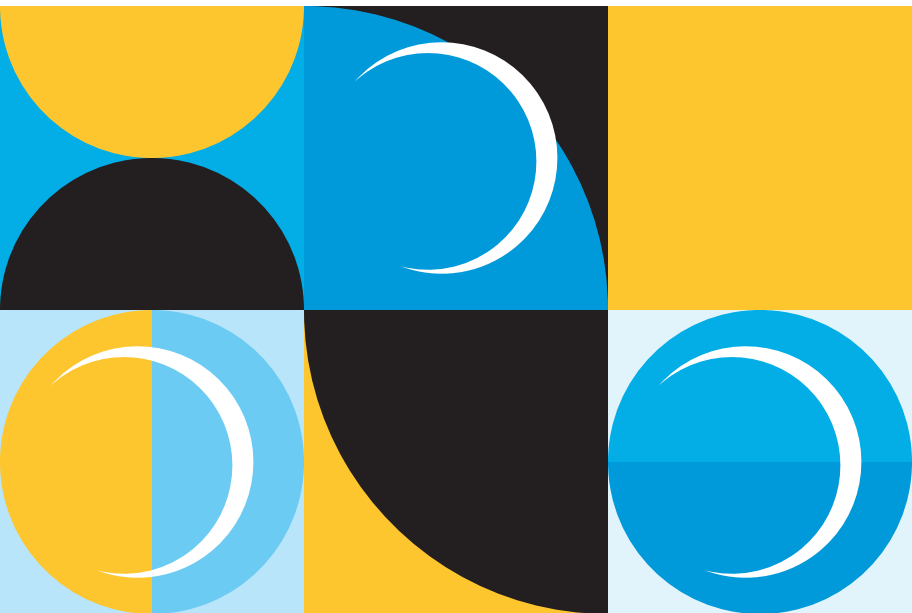

League of E.A.G.L.E.S. award winners are recognized at each region's Leadership Conference.
